CHÂTEAU

The property belongs to the same family since 1988. It is situated on the commune of Saint-Emilion and more precisely on the locality called « Lartigue ».



THE VINEYARD

Soil : sand and gravels

Area : 7,7 hectares.

Grape-varieties : 70 % Merlot, 15 % Cabernet Franc et 15 % Cabernet Sauvignon.

Harvest : Harvest by hand and by machine



VINIFICATION

Vinification : traditional in stainless steel—control of temperatures.

Ageing : 1/3 in new oak barrels + 1/3 in barrels of one year + 1/3 in barrels of 2 years. For a year.

TASTING COMMENTS



Color is red ruby, limpid and bright. Some golden tints.



Nose of red ripen fruits, jam.

Aromas of wood, toasted and roasted coffee notes.



Attack is nice ; the tannins are present et elegant. Even if the wine is young, it is very round . The final is persistent.

Well balanced.

Pairing : Red meat, cheese, game.
