CHÂTEAU

Currently owned by Mr Tournier, Château Rocher Figeac was founded in 1880 by one of his ancestors, called Rocher. He gave his name to the property. From generation to generation, the name Rocher has been perpetuated. This familial property, with a total superficies of 6.5 hectares, is located along the creek Tailhas and at the East of Libourne bypass, both on the appellations Pomerol and Saint-Emilion., very close to the famous Classified growth château Figeac,
The vines, 35 years old, benefit from a deep rooting on one of the best soils of the appellation St Emilion .



VINEYARD

Soil : gravel and iron oxide

Area : 3,9 hectares.

Grape-varieties : 85 % Merlot, 15 % Cabernet Franc.

Harvest : by hand



LA VINIFICATION

Traditional Vinification

traditional in temperature-regulated, 3 weeks at least

in 50 % cement, 50 % In stainless steel

Aged during 6 months in oak barrels of 1 wine—renewed every 4 years

Sustainable spraying. Vines are cultivated according to traditional methods.
Guyot simple cut.
