Transmitted from generation to generation, Dufourg vineyards are run by Elizabeth and her brother Alain Labat Dufourg.

The vineyards are of 80 hectares.

The vinification is made the traditional way, combining modern techniques of development such as temperature control, ancestral techniques such as long vatting, fining with albumin, etc..



VINEYARD

Soil : clay and chalk some silt fully drained

Area : 15 hectares.

Age of the vineyard : 40 years

Density of plantation : 6600 feet /ha.

Grape-varieties : 50 % Merlot, 30 % Cabernet Sauvignon et 15 % Cabernet Franc, 15 % Petit Verdot.

Harvest : mechanic
