CHÂTEAU

It was created in 1832 by the Dufilhot family. Claude Chevrot started to replant the vineyard in 1974. For more than thirty years, he has managed with the same passion this family property.



VINEYARD

Geographical situation : on the communes of Verdelais, Cadillac et Gabarnac.

Soil : limestone and clay in Verdelais, lighter and permeable grounds in Cadillac and Gabarnac

Area : 13 hectares of red vines

Age of the vineyard : more than 30 years old.

Grape-varieties : Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon & Cabernet Franc.

Culture : Traditional, Guyot simple and double pruning.



VINIFICATION

Traditional with sorting of the wine-harvest.

Control of the temperatures by thermoregulation.
Stainless vat house.

Ageing in oak barrels during 10 to 15 months with 25 to 30% of new barrels each year.



TASTINGS COMMENTS

Sustained color



Intense nose with red fruits aromas: blackcurrant and black berry.



The dominant feature of the Merlot associated with a controlled ageing in barrels offers roundness and suppleness.
